

Question-and-Answer-Camellia

Age-Group: Primary School

Subjects: Maths / Languages

Model-Source: Traditional model, *World's Best Origami*, Nick Robinson, ISBN 978-1-61564-053-9

Method: Fold two camellias of different colour, glue them together, insert a square of paper with the question on one side and another with the answer on the other side. Fill a box with these double-sided camellias. Make boxes with Maths-questions, others with vocabulary...

How to use: The children can use the box(es) on their own, perhaps while waiting for others to finish, or the box(es) can be used in a kind of game, for example:

A group of children sit in a circle around the question-up camellias.

One child starts, chooses a question, answers, turns the camellia around and checks, to see if the answer is correct. If so, it's the next child's turn. If incorrect, the child turns the camellia over again and chooses another question. This way, children who answer incorrectly, get more practice. The game goes on, until all camellias are on the answer-up side.
