

## World Champion

**Age-Group:** Primary School / early High School

**Subjects:** Geography / Languages

**Model-Source:** Traditional model, *Papierflugzeuge*, Nick Robinson, ISBN 978-3-8094-2211-2

**Method:** Let each child prepare five sentences or so on a country of his choice (schoolwork or homework). If it's a language class, the children prepare their sentences in the language being taught. Then teach the children to fold the airplane, maybe using old maps.

**How to use:** The teacher's plane flies first. He stands in front of the class and throws it. The child nearest to where the plane lands goes to the front, points to the country he chose on the map and recites his five sentences, then throws his own plane. The procedure is repeated until all children have recited their five sentences. Children who've had a turn are skipped, even if a plane lands close to them again (tip: let some children throw from the back or side of the class).
